MOWA Choctaw Services, LLC (MCS) is a construction and facilities-services company formed in 2010 and wholly owned by the MOWA Band of Choctaw Indians of southwest Alabama. As an SBA 8(a)-certified, tribally owned firm, MCS offers federal agencies a streamlined path to sole-source and set-aside contracting, with the capacity of established teaming partners behind every project. Profits return to the tribe.

CORE COMPETENCIES

Residential and building construction: new homes, remodeling and restoration, commercial and institutional building work.

Construction and site services: site preparation, concrete, specialty trades, small-scale vertical construction.

Facilities support services: building operations, grounds maintenance, facility management.

Real property leasing and management: commercial and industrial property in Mount Vernon, Alabama.

SBA-compliant joint ventures and teaming with established, bonded contractors (13 CFR 124.513, 125.9). MCS provides contract management and performs its required workshare with its own personnel; partners bring licensed trades, bonding, and federal past performance. SBA approves each JV before a sole-source award.

SOLE-SOURCE WITHOUT THE CAP

Because MCS is owned by an Indian tribe (13 CFR 124.3), agencies may award sole-source 8(a) contracts to MCS above the competitive thresholds that apply to individually owned 8(a) firms (13 CFR 124.506(b); FAR 19.805-1). Written justification above \$30M civilian (FAR 6.303-1); DoD per current procedures. Awards count toward small business goals.

The MOWA Band is state-recognized (Alabama, 1979), not federally recognized. SBA's 8(a) definition expressly includes state-recognized tribes, so MCS's tribal 8(a) authority applies in full.
